T = 1 Tono. Se indican efectos de portamento (inflexiones, "pitch bend") con líneas. El perfil temporal a ejecutar esta dado visualmente por la proporción de las líneas (ejemplos típicos: llega a altura anotada en la mitad o hacia final de la nota) y aplica para toda la duración de la nota (o notas si estan ligadas). La nota escrita es la altura de referencia para la aplicación del portamento, cuyo signo (ademas de forma) indica subir (+) o bajar (-) la nota la cantidad dada (ej. + 1/2 T = subir medio tono respecto a la nota escrita). Cuando se indica "~", significa llegar casi a la inflexión escrita (i.e. un poco menos) y cuando se indica "+" al final, significa superarla un poco.
